Family Access Membership Price:

Pay what you can (minimum: \$20)

With the Family Access Membership, the parent, their partner/spouse, and their dependent child(ren) are CMOSC members. All related adults accompanying them are free guests. Additionally, one unrelated adult (i.e. an adult friend or caregiver over 18 years old) can accompany the members as their free guest.

Membership at the Children's Museum of Sonoma County (CMOSC) provides free admission* during regular open days.

*Free admission is not valid for fundraising events (such as Snow Days) or admission to birthday parties.
